Laboratory Procedures

Stability:

Emideltide (acetate) is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the emideltide (acetate) in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. Emideltide (acetate) is slightly soluble in DMSO.

Further dilutions of the stock solution into aqueous buffers or isotonic saline should be made prior to performing biological experiments. Ensure that the residual amount of organic solvent is insignificant, since organic solvents may have physiological effects at low concentrations. Organic solvent-free aqueous solutions of emideltide (acetate) can be prepared by directly dissolving the solid in aqueous buffers. The solubility of emideltide (acetate) in PBS (pH 7.2) is approximately 10 mg/ml. We do not recommend storing the aqueous solution for more than one day.

Description

Emideltide, also known as delta sleep-inducing peptide (DSIP), is a synthetic nonapeptide sedative.¹ In vivo, emideltide (30 nmol/kg, i.v.) increases EEG delta activity and induces orthodox slow-wave sleep in free-moving rabbits. It also increases non-rapid eye movement (NREM) and total sleep in free-moving rats.²
