Laboratory Procedures

C12-TLRa is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the C12-TLRa in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. C12-TLRa is slightly soluble (0.1-1 mg/ml) in chloroform and methanol, and sparingly soluble (1-10 mg/ml) in DMSO.

Description

C12-TLRa is an adjuvant lipidoid (pK₂ = 6.42) with toll-like receptor 7/8 (TLR7/8) agonist activity.¹ Lipid nanoparticles (LNPs) containing C12-TLRa as a partial replacement for the ionizable lipidoid C12-113 (Item No. 39335) and encapsulating luciferase mRNA exhibit TLR7 agonist activity in HEK reporter cells and induce TNF-α production in DC2.4 cells. LNPs containing C12-TLRa and encapsulating luciferase mRNA have improved mRNA transfection and duration and induce a larger increase in the percentage of mature dendritic cells in mice when compared to LNPs containing C12-113. A severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) mRNA-LNP vaccine containing C12-TLRa induces higher serum IgG titers to the SARS-CoV-2 receptor-binding domain (RBD), as well as a higher number of CD80+PD-L2+ RBD-specific B cells, in the spleen in mice.
